CHECKLIST - ENTERING GERMANY FROM AN INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA

1. Check if you are entering Germany from a risk area. Find the list of risk areas here:

2. If possible, please book a direct flight to Germany, as entry regulations may differ in other EU countries.
3. Those entering from a risk area need to present a “certificate of required on-site presence”. Please contact JUNO (juno-international@hhu.de) and we can send you a template for the certificate.
4. Bring evidence of your booked accommodation in Düsseldorf. **Note that you can't quarantine in the university housing** and that you need a negative COVID-19 test to move in there. We therefore recommend to look for an accommodation off campus. JUNO can assist you with finding an accommodation.
5. Those entering Germany from a risk area are obliged to get tested on COVID-19 latest within 14 days after arrival. They are further obliged to go into quarantine until they receive a negative test result. Getting a test shortly before (max. 48 hours) or immediately after entering Germany (e.g. at the airport) may reduce the quarantine period of otherwise 14 days after entry. You are further obliged to get in touch with the local health authorities in Germany (“Gesundheitsamt”), to inform them that you have travelled from a risk country and to forward them the negative COVID-19 test results in order to get the approval of the “Gesundheitsamt”. JUNO can assist you with this, or you write an email to: gesundheitschutz@duesseldorf.de.

Either get a COVID-19 test in your home country before departure or, if this is not possible, at an airport in Germany (Düsseldorf, Frankfurt, München).

a) COVID-19 test in your home country:

- Check if your home country is on the following list. If so, a test from your country will be recognized:

- The test must be conducted **less than 48** hours prior to entry.

b) COVID-19 test at the airport in Düsseldorf:

- If you can't get a COVID-19 test in your home country, you can fly into Düsseldorf and get a test directly at the airport: <https://www.dus.com/en/services/unbesorgt-starten/corona-tests>
6. Please travel **directly** to your accommodation in Düsseldorf and stay in quarantine until you have the negative test results and have been in touch with the health authorities in Düsseldorf.
