

<h2>Contact Scholarships</h2> <p>for doctoral researchers from foreign universities</p>	
Who is eligible for funding?	Funding is provided for research stays at the HHU by doctoral students at a foreign university with which a cooperation agreement exists or is planned.
What is the objective of this scholarship?	To strengthen international partnerships in all faculties through the exchange of doctoral researchers (research stays).
Which conditions must be fulfilled?	Nominees of the partner university must have obtained their higher education entrance qualification outside Germany.
Scale and duration of funding	- € 600/month (in exceptional and justified cases € 1200/month) - Funding can be granted for up to 6 months
Who nominates?	The supervisor at HHU and the responsible person at the respective foreign university
Who cannot be nominated?	Doctoral researchers who are funded at the same time via another German or foreign scholarship organisation.
Deadline	An application can be made at any time, but should be submitted at least 4 weeks before the planned start of funding.
Documents to be submitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Application form - Short summary of planned research project (max.1 page) - CV of doctoral researcher - Copy of cooperation agreement or letter of HHU supervisor, confirming a planned cooperation agreement - Proof of enrolment for PhD studies at foreign university - Copy of higher education entrance exam - Copy of passport
What are the selection criteria?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Complete application - Have doctoral researchers from the same university already obtained an exchange scholarship in previous years? => Priority to universities without previous scholarships
Who makes the selection?	The Vice President for International Relations, a representative of the faculties, the Head of the International Office and the Head of the Central Scholarship Office at HHU
